

I further avow that my aforesaid waiver, release, discharge and agreement shall be applicable to any guest or participant in any program or event conducted or held by the Applicant at the above-described building, facility, or grounds.



<u>INSTRUCTIONS</u> (Use other instruction sheet for Lydgate Camping)

1. To apply for a camping permit, please complete the Request For Camping Permit application form and return completed application returned to:

- 2. Completed application form must be returned with payment (if applicable), in the form of a cashiers check or money order in US Dollars (no personal checks will be accepted), made payable to the "Director of Finance" and photo copies of the I.D.s of everyone eighteen (18) years of age or older. Do not send cash! Upon receipt of your application, your request will be reviewed, processed and logged. Mail-in application permits will be issued only up to one (1) month prior to the first camp date, to insure your receipt of the permit. Thereafter, permits must be obtained when you arrive on Kaua'i.
- 3. Camping Fees: State of Hawai'i Residents, who can show proof of residency, and that they have lived in the State of Hawai'i for a minimum of two hundred (200) days (i.e. photo copies of Hawai'i State driver's license that shows a Hawai'i address), are exempt for camping fees. Copies of I.D.s of all adults claiming Hawai'i residency must be included with completed application form. Lack of photocopies will result in the non-resident fee being charged.
 - a. For anyone unable to show proof of residency or non-residents of the State of Hawai'i, eighteen (18) years of age or older, the camping fee is **three** (\$3.00) dollars PER ADULT, PER NIGHT. Minors, seventeen (17) years of age or younger are free and must be accompanied by at least one (1) adult.
- 4. We accept reservations from large eleemosynary groups registered with the State of Hawai'i (i.e., Scouts, Sierra Groups, etc.). Please submit proof of registration when you apply for a permit. Names of all adult and minor campers must be listed on the group or organization's official letter head. Photo copies of group or organization's I.D.s must be included along with photo copies regular state driver's license or I.D. card for all adults.
