

Camping: Salt Pond Park (18 miles from Lihue)

1. Take highway 50.
2. At the end of Hanapepe Town, turn left onto Lele Road.
3. Continue for a quarter mile passing dry salt pond beds.
4. Camping is designated on the left side of the park.

Salt Pond Park (5.9 acres) has the following amenities: pavilions, comfort stations, cold showers, picnic tables. Camp ground closes each Tuesday at 10:00 a.m. for maintenance and reopens at 12:00 p.m. each Wednesday. Lifeguards are on duty from 9:00 a.m. to 5:00 p.m. daily. This is a beautiful bay for swimming and snorkeling.

Camping: Lucy Wright Park (25 miles from Lihue)

1. Take highway 50 to Waimea Town.
2. Turn left on Alawai Road, entering Waimea Town, passing the bridge.
3. Camp site can be seen from the highway on your left.

Lucy Wright Park (4.48 acres) has the following amenities: pavilion, comfort station, cold showers, picnic tables. Camp ground closes each Monday at 10:00 a.m. for maintenance and reopens at 12:00 p.m. each Tuesday. The ocean water is brackish due to the river mouth situated right next to this park. Good area for surfing.
