- b. Jamboree

- Justin Barrios- proposed that a "FRIENDLY" competition be held on the Big Island in late 2022 since the July competition is has not made any progress and nothing is finalized yet.
- Desiree Page- will follow up with Bobby and Doug to see what the issues are, and if they are still committed to organizing the competition on Maui in July.
- Many feel like it is too late to have the competition in July if a venue is not already secured.
- Possible Big Island locations- Wailoa State Park or St. Joseph School.
- "FRIENDLY" competition for Hawaii residents only to prep for the February in Maui. To work way through the venue & get experience. Use same ISA format to get experience.
- Needs to have a different name so it's not to be confused with the Official Jamboree in February.
- Jamrodaree- possible name? Add to June's Agenda to follow up.
- Proposal—swap competition dates. Big Island October or November 2022 (friendly, fun, only Hawaii climbers) and Maui February 2023- official ISA comp.
- After 2023- AAA will need to be consistent on having the competition on last weekend in February every year.
- Accommodating mainland climbers is very beneficial to Hawaii competitors. AAA has a lot of outside resources.
- There was a discussion about whether to put a cap on the amount of mainland competitors allowed in February, and the possibility of reserving spots for local climbers.
- Having enough judges, score keepers, and volunteers is essential to having a fair competition.
